

#### Rules

The 6th International Music Competition "Walled Town" has the purpose to promote the Cultural Image of Cittadella Walled Town as a Cultural Centre of excellence. The Competition will be held in the sites of the Town that have an Historical and Artistic importance.

#### Art. 1 – Competition announcement

The Competition is open to musicians, soloists or groups, of any gender and nationality and will take place entirely ONLINE.

Art. 2 – Sections	
Section I.a: Piano Soloists	Category A1, A2, A3, B, C, D, E, F, I, I.1
Section I.b: Piano Soloists Amateurs	from age 35 and up with no age limit
Section II.a: String Soloists	Category A1, A2, A3, B, C, D, E, F, I, I.1 TO BE NOTICED: Double Bass Players of categories E, F, I, I.1 can compete for the award of the Bottesini Prize (see article 4 for the program)
Section II.b: String Soloists Amateurs	from age 35 and up with no age limit
Section III: Wind Soloists	Category A1, A2, A3, B, C, D, E, F, I, I.1
Section IV: Guitar Soloists	Category A1, A2, A3, B, C, D, E, F, I, I.1
Section V Chamber Music (form duo to sextet. Piano 4 hands included, 2 Pianos invluded)	Category A1, A2, A3, B, C, D, E, F, I, I.1

## Art. 3 – How to apply, communication of results

## How to apply

Competitors will send a good quality full-length, fixed-frame video in which they will perform all the program required by this announcement.

The video will be uploaded by the Competition to its YouTube channel (https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCaXKpUI0voEIZOuYRfQdG7Q?view\_as=subscriber) and will be viewed by the members of the Juries.

### For how to apply and send video files, see art. 8 of this announcement

#### **Communication of results**

The results will be communicated on May 31, 2021 at the end of the video auditions by the Juries and will be published on the Competition website (<u>www.concorsocittamurata.com</u>) as well as simultaneously sent by email to the Competitors.

# Art. 4 – Categories, Programs and duration

### **TO BE NOTICED:**

- The Juries are allowed not to consider the executions in the case in which the time limit specified below is not respected
- For sections V will be considered the average age of the component the ensemble.
- The Competitor can apply to a category higher than their age or apply to different sections of the Competition, but can't apply to more than one category in the same section

### **Programs and duration**

Category A1: born from 1-Jan-2015 to 31-Dec-2015 – Free program maximum lenght 6 minutes

Category A2: born from 1-Jan-2014 to 31-Dec-2014 - Free program maximum lenght 8 minutes

Category A3: born from 1-Jan-2013 to 31-Dec-2013 - Free program maximum length 10 minutes

Category B sections I.a, II.a, III, IV, V: born from 1-Jan-2010 to 31-Dec-2012 - Free program maximum length 12 minutes

Category C sections I.a, II.a, III, IV, V: born from 1-Jan-2007 to 31-Dec-2009 - Free program maximum length 15 minutes

Category D sections I.a, II.a, III, IV, V: born from 1-Jan-2004 to 31-Dec-2006 - Free program maximum length 18 minutes

Category E sections II.a (**String soloists**), III (**Wind soloists**), IV (**Guitar soloists**), V (**Chamber Music**):

**born from 1-Jan-2001 to 31-Dec-2003 -** Free program maximum length 20 minutes TO BE NOTICED: For double bass players who intend to compete for the award of the *Bottesini Prize*, the program must necessarily include two pieces by Giovanni Bottesini at the competitor's choice

Category E section I.a (Piano soloists): born from 1-Jan-2001 to 31-Dec-2003

a) D. Scarlatti: One keyboard sonata

b) One Study chosen among that of Casella, Chopin, Debussy, Scriabin.

c) Free program maximum length 15 minutes

It's not allowed to repeat works played in the first round.

All works must be played by heart.

## Category F (born from 1-Jan-1997 to 31-Dec-2000)

Only for Sections II.a **String soloists**, III **Wind soloist**, IV **Guitar soloist**, V **Chamber Music** - Free program maximum length 25 minutes (for sections II.a and III, even if it is not compulsory, is appreciated the inclusion in the program of solo music pieces without piano accompaniment). TO BE NOTICED: For double bass players who intend to compete for the award of the *Bottesini Prize*, the program must necessarily include two pieces by Giovanni Bottesini at the competitor's choice

Category F (born from 1-Jan-1997 to 31-Dec-2000)

Only for Section I.a, Piano Soloists

a) J.S. Bach: One prelude and fugue form Well Tempered Clavier

b) One Study chosen among that of Bartok, Casella, Chopin, Debussy, Liszt, Prokof'ev, Rachmaninoff, Scriabin and Stravinskij.

c) Free program maximum length 20 minutes

All works must be played by heart

# Categories I (born from 1-Jan-1991 to 31-Dec-1996), and I.1 (born before 1-Jan-1991 no age limits)

Only for Sections II.a **String soloists**, III **Wind soloist**, IV **Guitar soloist**, V **Chamber Music** - Free program maximum length 30 minutes (for sections II.a and III, even if it is not compulsory, is appreciated the inclusion in the program of solo music pieces without piano accompaniment).

TO BE NOTICED: For double bass players who intend to compete for the award of the *Bottesini Prize*, the program must necessarily include two pieces by Giovanni Bottesini at the competitor's choice

Free program, maximum lenght 20 minutes.

TO BE NOTICED: the application for Section I.b must be enclosed with a self-certification attesting to the amateur nature of its Pianist activity (the form can be downloaded from the website menu at the section "application forms")

#### Section II.b String Soloists amatuer

### From age 35 and up with no age limit

Free program, maximum lenght 20 minutes.

TO BE NOTICED: the application for Section II.b must be enclosed with a self-certification attesting to the amateur nature of its String player activity (the form can be downloaded from the website menu at the section "application forms")

#### Art. 5 – Juries

The juries will be formed by concert player, Teacher of Conservatory, Orchestral musicians. The score will be expressed by secret ballot; the average will be calculated excluding the lower and the higher score. In the case in which a component of the Jury is also the Teacher of a competitor, the component of the Jury won't express any scores about the competitor. In this case the score expressed by the President of the Jury will have double value.

#### Art. 6 – Scores, prices

The winner of a category is the competitor with the highest score not lower than 98/100. First place for the competitors with score not lower than 95/100 Second place for the competitors with score not lower than 90/100 Third place for the competitors with score not lower than 85/100 All the Diplomas will be sent by ordinary mail *and* by e-mail to the Competitor's address. For all the competitors first, second and third placed, there will be a diploma of merit.
